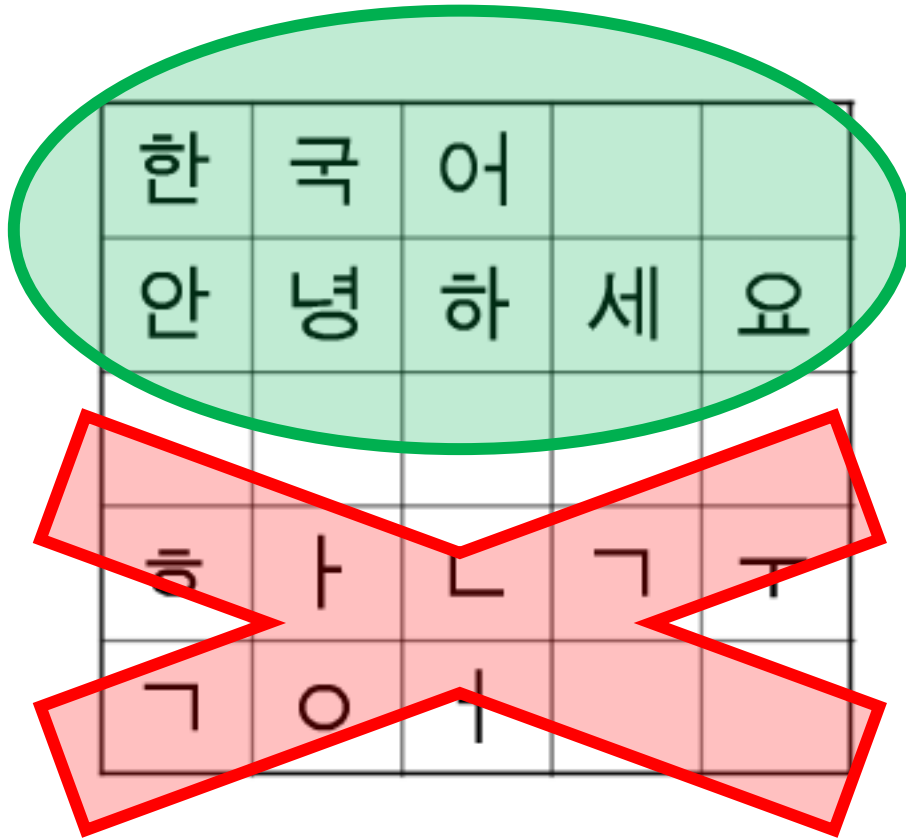


# Han'gŭl Syllable blocks

# Syllable blocks

---



- ▶ 한글 letters are combined into syllable blocks.
- ▶ Sequential writing is not allowed.
- ▶ In a syllable block,
  - ▶ Min. 1 C letter + 1 V letter

- ▶ Horizontal vowel letters

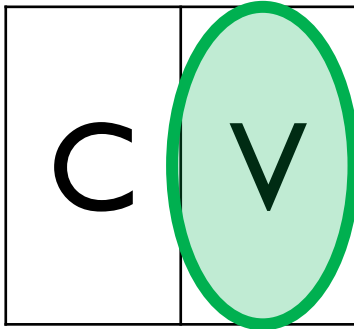

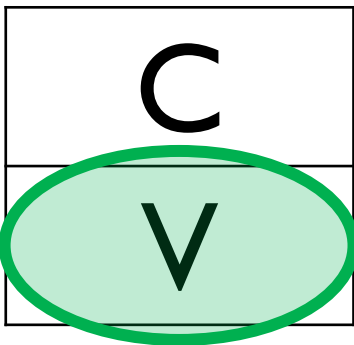

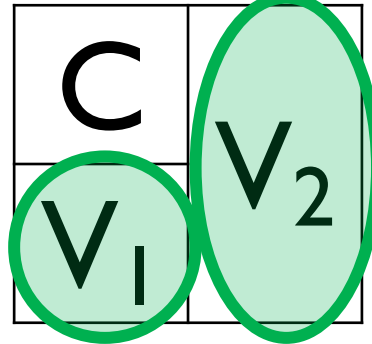
with a vertical V



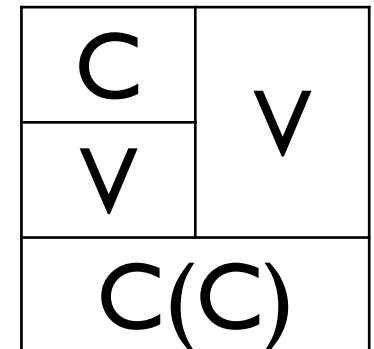
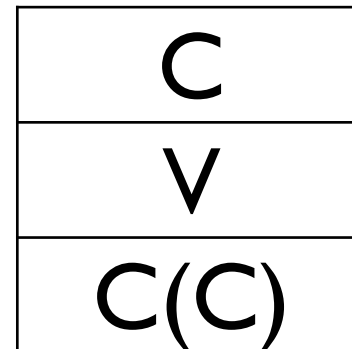
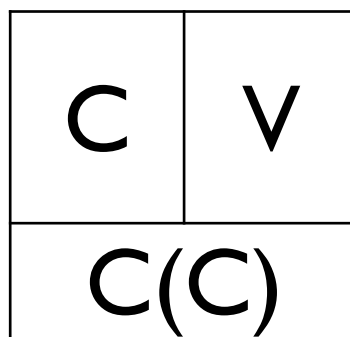

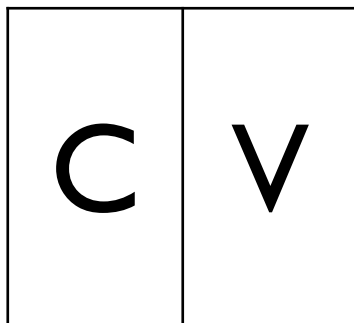

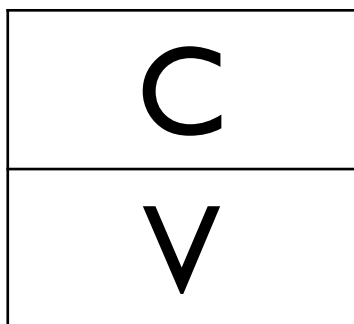

---

- ▶ Each & every lexical item is followed by a space.

- ▶ No space between a word and a particle

- ▶ 'To be' verb is attached to the preceding noun.

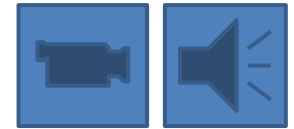
